**There are 3 History sequences to choose from to satisfy core requirements.**

## **World History Sequence**

HIST 1010 World History to 1648

Course description: A survey of world civilization from prehistory to 1648.

HIST 1020 World History Since 1648

Course description: A survey of world civilization from 1648 to the present.

## **Western Civilization Sequence**

HIST 1060 Western Civilization to 1648

Course description: This course surveys the history of the west from its earliest beginnings to 1600. Students will explore competing views and voices in ancient and medieval western history that gave rise to the social and political systems, wars, economics, and cultures of western civilization.

HIST 1070 Western Civilization since 1648

Course description: his course surveys the history of the west from 1600 to the modern era. Students will explore competing views and voices in pre-modern and modern western history that gave rise to the social and political systems, wars, economics, and cultures of western civilization.

## **U.S. History Sequence**

HIST 2010 U.S. History to 1865

Course description: A survey of the political, economic, social and intellectual movements and institutions of the United States from colonial times to 1865.

HIST 2020 U.S. History Since 1865

Course description: A survey of the political, economic, social and intellectual movements and institutions of the United States from 1865 to the present.

**These three sequences are all equally acceptable sequences to fulfill Area IV: History, Social and Behavioral Sciences AUM Core Curriculum requirements. *Only the sequences are equal; the courses are not interchangeable.***
