

The Economics minor curriculum will consist of 4 courses with a total of 12 credit hours.

The Economic minor will consist of the following courses:

Students will have to choose at least one: course from the two listed courses below

ECON 4100 Intermediate Macro-Economics (3)

ECON 4110 Intermediate Micro-Economics (3)

The remainder of the courses will be electives chosen from the list below:

ECON 3500, ECON 3520, ECON 3540, ECON 3600, ECON 3800, ECON 3850, ECON 4050, ECON 4270, ECON 4600, ECON 4650, ECON 4700, ECON 4970, ECON 4200, ECON 4300, ECON 4310 and other approved electives by the department head

Note: 1) Please note that students will have to take the prerequisite courses for ECON 4100 and ECON 4110 as well.

2) Students who are counting ECON 4970 Special Problem: Chinese Economy towards the minor, cannot count ECON 4200: Chinese Economy towards the minor.

3) Students who are counting ECON 4970 Special Problem: Industrial Organization towards the minor, cannot count ECON 4300: Industrial Organization towards the minor.

4) Students who are counting ECON 4970 Special Problem: Games and Strategy towards the minor, cannot count ECON 4310: Games and Strategy towards the minor.
